

Chair of Judges

- Assist and advise the Show Organising committee on all aspects of Showjumping
- Act as adjudicator on formal objections, in accordance to Rule 198.5
- Submit a Chair of judges Show report to British Showjumping in a timely fashion.
- The Chairman of judges can also be appointed and act as a Lead Official for one arena at the multi-ring show.
- The Show Organiser/Organising committee must allow sufficient time and resources for the Chair of Judges to carry out the relevant duties and checks.

Lead Official

- Assist and advise the Show Organiser/Organising committee on all aspects of Showjumping
- Ensure that all aspects of the event are run in accordance with the Rules of the Association
- Act as adjudicator on formal objections, in accordance to Rule 198.5 (in the absence of an appointed Chairman of Judges).
- The Show Organiser/Organising committee must allow sufficient time and resources for the lead official to carry out the relevant duties and checks.

Officiating Judge

- Assist and advise the Show Organiser/Organising committee on all aspects of Showjumping
- Ensure that all aspects of the event are run in accordance with the Rules of the Association
- Be responsible for the current competition in the arena
- Be responsible for the course once walked
