

# National 148cms & under Pony Guide - Riders 16 yrs & under

This competition guide will help you identify the classes that both you and your pony are eligible to compete in (Rule 77.16.4 applies) and accrue points which will apply to the regional 148cms leagues. Should the rider fall outside this age category their accrued points will be applied to the league relevant to their age. In addition to these classes, there are also specific 128cms/138cms pony classes.

### LEAGUE POINTS TABLE

Points are based on 1:5 ratio

Placing	Bronze & Silver (1.10m)	Silver (from 1.15m)	Gold
1st	10 points	20 points	30 points
2nd	8 points	16 points	24 points
3rd	6 points	12 points	18 points
4th	4 points	8 points	12 points
5th	3 points	6 points	9 points
6th	2 points	4 points	6 points
Double Clear's	5 points	10 points	15 points

NB: In instances where competitions are run under Table A with two rounds not against the clock, those pony/rider combinations that finish in equal first place will be awarded double clear points only.

### Rider Age Allocation

Points are allocated on both class and riders age. Based on the following rider age groups, through to the end of the calendar year in which this age was attained, league points may be allocated into a different pony height league.

Rider Age	League Allocation
12 yrs & under	128cms & Under
14 yrs & under	138cms & Under
16 yrs & under	148cms & Under
