


Judges Progression Chart

Details of how to progress through the levels are detailed below, including the key criteria and competencies which need to be met for each progression.

Officials can progress onto the FEI ladder by applying to British Showjumping. Once endorsed by British Showjumping, applications will be then submitted to the FEI for assessment, approval & inclusion on the Judges list.



UPGRADING PROCESS


Level 1 to 2

RETENTION AND CONTINUNING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT (CPD) NOTES

- All officials must attend an Officials Training Event every 2 years
- Levels 1 / 2 must officiate at a minimum of 6 British Showjumping show days a year
- Level 3 must officiate at a minimum of 10 British Showjumping show days a year. Must demonstrate commitment to CPD
- All levels must complete the minimum show days a year to be retained at current level, if not, they may be downgraded.
