BEF World Class Podium Potential Pathway

Age:

No older than 25 years old as at 31 December 2018

Eligibility:

Eligible to compete for Great Britain and hold a current British passport.

Full competing members of British Showjumping on selection and reside in England.

Athletes are no older than 18 years of age as at 31 December 2018:

- Minimum of 4 first round clear rounds over a 1.40m track excluding special competitions
- Minimum of 4 double clear rounds at 1.35m competitions
- Counting score in any round of a medal winning GBR Junior European Team
- Top 15 individual placing at the Junior European Championships
- Counting score in any round of the Nations Cup team competition at the Junior European Championships.
- A clear round in any round of a Junior CSIOJ Nations Cup, Grand Prix or European Championship

Athletes are no older than 21 years of age as at 31 December 2018:

- Minimum of 4 clear rounds in 1.45m competitions excluding special competitions
- Counting score in any round of a medal winning GBR Young Rider European Team
- Top 15 individual placing at the Young Rider European Championships
- Counting score in any round of the Nations Cup Team Competition at the Young Rider European Championships
- A clear round in a 2* Grand Prix

Athletes are no older than 25 years of age as at 31 December 2018:

- Minimum of 6 clear rounds at 1.45m competitions excluding special competitions
- Clear round in any of the Nations Cup or Grand Prix at the Young Rider European Championships
- Top 10 individual placing at the Young Rider European Championships
- Double clear round in a 2* Grand Prix (double clear round in the initial two rounds of any three round 2* Grand Prix)
