HOW TO QUALIFY FOR THE SEMI-FINALS

If hoping to qualify via the Regional League route, qualification will be based on points gained between 1st April - 30th June in the current calendar year.

If via the direct qualifiers, the semi final venue will be allocated in line with those qualifying via the leagues ie. by Members Area

WHAT TO EXPECT AT THE SEMI-FINALS

- The Semi-Final will run under Table A8
- Three rounds of heights 1.20m-1.25m-1.30m
- The Final will run Table A10 and a 1st round height of 1.25m.
